

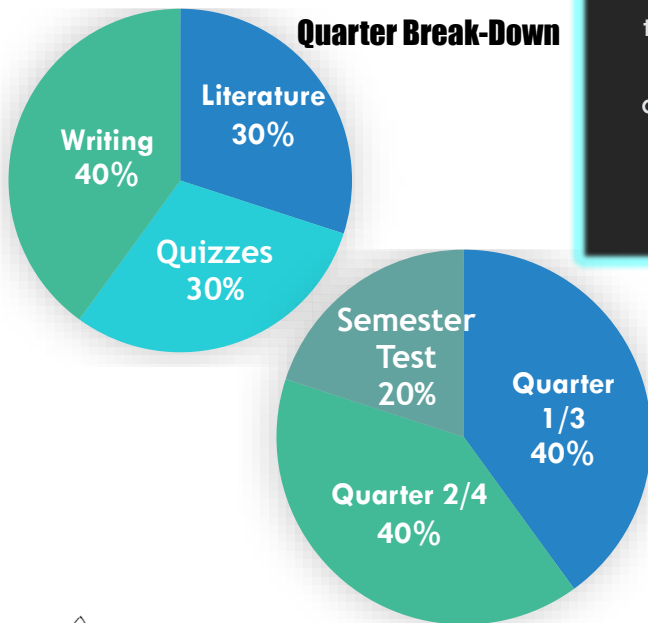

EXPECTATIONS



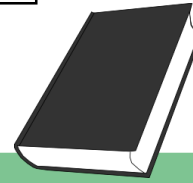
Be respectful by using appropriate language, listening when others are talking, being on time, and using materials appropriately.
